# SHELFANGER PARISH COUNCIL

**MINUTES** of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 5 September 2024 at 6.30 pm at Shelfanger Village Hall.

- 1. Chairman's Welcome: The Vice Chair opened the meeting and welcomed everyone present, and received apologies for absence from Mr Stephen Groom and County Cllr Catherine Rowett.
- 2. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 27 June 2024 The Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 27 June, previously circulated to all members, were proposed for approval by Cllr M Hurst and seconded by Cllr M Paines and unanimously agreed.
- 3. To record declarations of interest and approve any requests for dispensations for disclosable pecuniary interests or other interests: None were received
- 4. To hear from members of the public:
  - A member of the public brought to the attention of the meeting that a
    previous Councillor was still showing on the website as current Clerk to action
    deletion.
  - Another member of the public reported attending the surgery of Green Party MP Adrian Ramsay. Issues which were brought to his attention was the flooding in Shelfanger, the proposed development in Winfarthing. AR confirmed he would be speaking to County Cllr Catherine Rowett and thanked the attendee for brining these things to his attention.
- 5. To receive the Cllr Catherine Rowett CR's report was read out to the meeting in her absence and is attached.
- **6. To receive Clerk's report -** The Clerk's report was read out.
  - Planning Fieldview Single storey side extension has been approved.
  - o **Ford Heywood Road** Following a discussion with the farmer, his ditches were found to not be at fault. If the flooding at the ford continues to be a problem this winter, this is to be reported to Highways **Clerk to action.**
  - o Village Hall Accounts Year Ending 31.03.24 Update requested and confirmation received for receipt by the end of the year.
  - **Church Road Flooding** The ditch had been emptied and the system running under Church Road. This has not alleviated the whole problem and the owners have been requested to cleanse the ditch and pipes.
  - o **SAM2 Speed Camera** The application for a Parish Partnership Scheme grant has been submitted and the outcome awaited before ordering the camera. Clerk to contact Diss Town Council to determine resources needed to re-locate the camera once installed **Clerk to action**.

The Council have been contacted and confirmed they will be added to their emptying schedule once positioned. Clerk to action installation.
- Correspondence Correspondence has been received concerning the overgrown footpath at the end of Druids lane and the field attached situated behinds Jacks Barn. The track on the south side will be cut back in the winter by the farmer. The owner of the hedge and field to the north could not be found, but the website where this information can be purchased was passed on to the correspondent.
- o **Environment Agency Surveyors** The Environment Agency carried out a survey during the summer months to help decide which flooding defence option is affordable and viable. Feedback pending **Clerk to action.**

- 8. To receive updates from individual Council members: Cllr M Hurst reported on the meeting held at Gissing regarding flood defences. Both her and Cllr Paul Chambers attended and were impressed by the work carried out to upgrade flood defences by slowing the water flow. Dams and hollows in the meadows worked to slow the water and local farmers were encouraged to apply for grant money from the Norfolk Waveney and River Trusts.
- **9. Boyland Common Report -** Cllr P Ross went through her report (attached).

### 10. Planning:

- Application No: 2024/2476 housing development for 21 houses in Winfarthing. Concern was shown for increased water discharge into the system, which ultimately will flow into Shelfanger. A general discussion took place and it was agreed that a request be put to planners to ensure the underground waste water tanks be put in place first and note Shelfanger Parish Council's concern regarding water flow Clerk to action
- Application No: 2022/0639 amendment to planning for Cherry Tree House, Heywood Road. Concerns were raised about the discharge of water into the waterways.
